The name of God is an incredibly precious gift and treasure. Think about what it means to know God's name. It means that you know who He is. And who God is is what God does. That is why there are several names that we know for God. For example, He is "Lord", "Father", "Wonderful Counselor", "Savior", "Jesus". Each of these names tells us about what God is and does for us. And God wants you to use these names. That's why He makes them known to you in the Bible. And how do you use God's names rightly? You call upon Him with those names seeking anything and everything you need, giving Him thanks and praise for all He has done. You don't seek help or comfort from the dead or the stars or money or the celebrities or luck or rulers or scientists. These are false gods. They cannot help you. Worse yet, they are some of the masks behind which the devil likes to hide to deceive you. You also have God's name so that you can confess it before the world, shining the light of truth into the darkness. And what is even more wonderful than having and knowing God's name? It is to know that in Holy Baptism, God has placed His saving name upon you so that you are His beloved child and He is your dear Father. May our Father, for the sake of His Son Jesus Christ, forgive us for our failure to use His name and or to use it rightly and by His Holy Spirit teach us to call upon His name in every trouble with all boldness and confidence.
